### **MASS INFORMATION**

Spiritual communion when you cannot attend celebration of the Eucharist: As part of efforts to prevent the spread of COVID-19 (coronavirus), public celebration of Mass is suspended in the Roman Catholic Diocese of Saskatoon – and in Catholic dioceses across the county. Although the Catholic faithful have a dispensation from the duty to attend Sunday Eucharist until further notice, it is still possible to make an Act of Spiritual Communion to unite oneself in prayer to Jesus Christ. An example of such a prayer is:

"My Jesus, I believe that you are present in the Blessed Sacrament. I love You above all things and I desire You in my soul. Since I can not now receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. As though You were already there, I embrace You and unite myself wholly to You; permit not that I should ever be separated from You. Amen."
