

As visioned by John in the reading from Revelation, from the heavens to the earth the saints are the ones who

"long to see God's face" (Psalm 24). The rewards of these blessings are offered both in this life and the next, but they are spiritual riches rather than material. So, are we praying to win the lottery, or for the kind of holiness that comes from practising the Beatitudes? As the liturgical year draws to an end and the winter darkness is setting in, it is worth asking what we really long for most, and adjusting our compasses as necessary. **CCCB**
