Bishop Mark Hagemoen will celebrate Mass at 11 a.m. Sunday, Feb. 2 at the Cathedral of the Holy Family, 123 Nelson Road, Saskatoon, praying for all consecrated religious women and men, with fellowship afterwards. Everyone is welcome to join in person at the Cathedral Feb. 2 or to pray live or later via live-stream video at <a href="https://saskatoonmass.com">https://saskatoonmass.com</a>.

After Mass, there will be a time of fellowship in the hall.

Pope Saint John Paul II instituted this day of prayer for women and men in consecrated life in 1997. The Feast of the Presentation is also known as Candlemass Day; a day on which candles are traditionally blessed, symbolizing Christ who is the light of the world. So too, those in consecrated life are called to reflect the light of Jesus Christ in our world. 
ed throughout the communities, including St Ann's.

This year's celebration echoes the 2025 Jubilee Year by blessing and praying for the ministry of Catholic health care which is essential to the Church's pilgrimage of hope.
