In good health, the Holy Father often asked the faithful to pray for him. He taught that we need "the courage to trust that the Lord is listening to us" and "the courage to knock at the door...."

So, as he battles grave illness, we muster the courage to knock at Lord's door with a special online ***Rosary for Pope Francis*** on **Thursday, February 27 at 7:00 p.m. ET**. We will pray for healing for the servant of the servants of God and for everyone who ailing around the world.

World Day of Prayer 2025 *"I Made You Wonderful"* (Psalm 139: 1-18) - The World Day of Prayer is traditionally celebrated on the first Friday of March, though communities can choose other dates. A different participating country writes the service each year, and for 2025, it was Christian women of the Cook Islands. In Saskatoon, ecumenical services will be held on **Friday, March 7** at several locations, including **St. Martin United Church**, 2617 Clarence Ave. S. starting at 1:30 p.m.; at **St. Matthew Anglican Church**, 135-109th Street, starting at 2 p.m.; and at **St. John Bosco Catholic Church**, 1202 Avenue O S., starting at 2 p.m. As well, all are invited to the national online World Day of Prayer service at 12 p.m. on **Saturday, March 15** led by members of the Women's Inter-Church Council of Canada.
