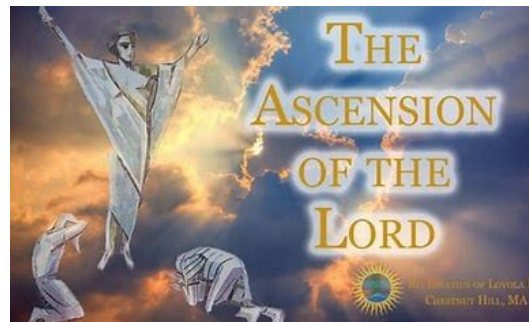

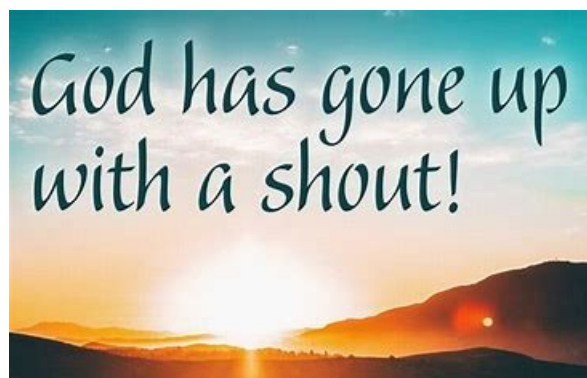

All the speeches and messages Pope Leo XIV has given since becoming pope on May 8 are available on the Vatican website, which should be checked before sharing supposed quotes and videos. The recently-revised Vatican website — www.vatican.va — offers all papal texts, including the texts of the Holy Father’s video messages, in multiple languages.
