Diocesan prayer: (Season of Creation Sept 1-Oct 4) - Heavenly Father, grant that the future of creation, our world, the Church and all people may be protected in your hands, and that we may live in true hope, justice, and peace in communion and right relationship with each other, with all of creation, and with You, our living God.

Season of Creation Sept. 1 to Oct. 4: "Peace With Creation" – The season of Creation, a time of prayer, reflection and action, is marked each year from Sept. 1 (World Day of Prayer for Creation) to Oct. 4 (Feast of St. Francis of Assisi, patron saint of the environment). Find resources, information, prayers, etc. on the Season of Creation website: https://seasonofcreation.org/ The Biblical text for this year's celebration is Isaiah 32:14-18 in which the prophet Isaiah pictured the desolated creation without peace because of the lack of justice and the broken relationship between God and humankind. This description of devastated cities and wastelands eloquently stresses the fact that human destructive behaviours have a negative impact on the Earth. Creation will find peace when justice is restored, says the prophet. There is still hope and the expectation for a peaceful Earth. To hope in a biblical context does not mean to stand still and quiet, but to act, pray, change, and reconcile with creation and the Creator in unity, metanoia (repentance), and solidarity. NOTE: Bishop Mark Hagemoen will use new Mass prayers for the care of creation at a celebration of the Eucharist at 9 a.m. Sunday, Oct. 12 on the Thanksgiving Weekend at Cathedral of the Holy Family in Saskatoon (live-streamed: https://saskatoonmass.com) The Vatican announced earlier this year that a new formulary of prayers and biblical readings for a Mass of care of creation were added to the Roman Missal - Pope Francis used the new prayers at a celebration of the Eucharist in July.


